A revision has been made to the means of transportation to school that used to require parents/guardians to drop off and pick up their children.

- Up until now, the elementary schools have asked parents/guardians to take their children to and from the school district. However, a revision has been made to allow students in the fifth grade and above to commute to school alone at the discretion of their parents/guardians.
- Students in the fifth grade and above may be allowed to commute to school by bicycle.

All students are to take the Eiken (English proficiency) and Kanken (kanji aptitude) exams, and external instructors provide study courses and supervision for club activities. The school has an auditorium where all students can study together. Also, there is space in front of each grade's classroom for self-study.
