Overview of Takayasu Elementary and Junior High School




Located at the foot of Mt. Takayasu in the northeast part of Yao City, the school is blessed with a lush natural environment and a fascinating historical and cultural heritage.

In AY 2016, the facilities of Takayasu Elementary School and Takayasu Junior High School were combined into a new school building. In April 2019, the two schools integrated into a compulsory education school that provides nine years of education at one school.

While ensuring Takayasu's traditional education, which allows students to take pride in their hometown and enhances their ability to thrive in the future, Takayasu Elementary and Junior High School, as a small-scale special school, will continue to advance its distinctive educational activities by, for example, enhancing English education to develop global talent.

If wishing to enroll in a small-scale special school

Eligibility

Children residing in Yao City who will enroll in an elementary school or the primary education section of a compulsory education school in Yao City next academic year, or who are in the sixth grade at one of these schools.

Procedure

Please complete the necessary procedure within the application period. Please see Yao City's website or contact the Board of Education.

Points to consider.

- Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation in the educational activities of Takayasu Elementary and Junior High School.
- The guardian of the child is responsible for ensuring the child's safety while commuting to school.
- Students will be required to attend the small-scale special school until graduation and will not be able to transfer to another school. (Except when moving or for any other unavoidable reason)

Initiatives for integrated elementary and junior high school education while sharing the same facilities

Takayasu Elementary and Junior High School provides nine years of consistent education as a compulsory education school, which integrates the primary education section for the first to sixth grades (equivalent to elementary school) and the secondary education section for the seventh to ninth grades (equivalent to junior high school).
